THE SLOVAK AID TO UKRAINE

Since the beginning of Russian aggression within:

- diplomatic support (restrictions),
- weapons, ammunition,
- aid for refugees,
- humanitarian aids, (medical, food, clothes,
- financial support.

By government, humanitarian organizations, individual peoples

SPECIFIC AID FROM THE SLOVAK GOVERNMENT TO UKRAINE RESEARCHERS

- The Government office of the Slovak Republic, as the partial executor of the RECOVERY PLAN FOR EUROPE specifically component 9, which precisely sounds: "More effective management and strengthening of research, development, and innovation funding" in May 2022, issued the call for applications, which name was: "Scholarships for excellent researchers threatened by the war in Ukraine".
- The goal of the call was to support Ukrainian researchers, whose life and career was directly threatened by the ongoing war in Ukraine, by their relocation to Slovakia



WHAT THE CONTENT OF SUPPORT IS

The financial support for selected Ukrainian researchers includes:

- Stipendium,
- research allowance and
- overhead allowance,

for only one year with the possibility of extension depending on the military situation in Ukraine



BUEM CONTRIBUTION

- Contacted our 10 Ukrainian partner universities from Kharkiv, Odesa,
 Mikolayv, Kiiv, Chernivtsi, Lviv, Uzhhorod
- Acceptance from 13 UA researchers with university approvement
- Preparation of the project applications
- The Government office has decided to approve 12 applications, as follows:
- 3 researchers, highest category R4, Leading Researcher;
- 2 researchers category R3, Established Researcher;
- 5 researchers category R2, Recognized Researcher;
- 2 researchers category R1, First Stage Researcher.



BUEM IN OVERAL STATISTICS

- According to official data, there were submitted in total 131 applications, with almost a 90% acceptance rate.
- Out of those 101 successful applicants, there were 10 universities (7 public and 3 private ones).
- Out of 56 successful applications from academia, 12 were granted to BUEM and as well 12 were granted to the largest public university in Slovakia
- Personally, I'm thankful for the fact the acceptance rate of BUEM's applications was at the highest level, compared to all universities.



CURRENT STATUS

8 Ukrainian researchers are already in BUEM (Kharkiv 6, Kiiv-1, Chernivtsi-1)

The group consists:

7 female, 1 male researcher,

Three Ukrainian researchers (male 60 - from Odesa-1, Chernivtsi-2) did not receive permission to cross the border even after multiple interventions by the military authorities, as well as at the Ministry of Education of Ukraine.



BENEFITS FOR BOTH SIDES

- Peaceful conditions for scientific works
- Opportunity to work without interruption of all original teaching activities in own alma maters in Ukraine in an online form
- Depending of common cooperation in the field of science and research
- Support for joint publications of scientific articles in scientific journals registered in Scopus or Web of Science databases
- Assistance in the recovery process in Ukraine after Russian aggression
