



Opportunities for the internalization of higher education in current conditions

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International cooperation around the world is now considered one of the most important indicators for determining quality in the field of education and science and at the same time one of the main tools for ensuring and improving it.

Internationalization has largely ceased to be a specialized activity and has become a more centralized, carefully organized and deliberate component of institutional action, and universities around the world are moving from a reactive to a proactive stance in this matter.

- cooperation with international educational organizations, foundations and associations;
- participation in grant projects;
- academic mobility;
- double degree programs;
- teaching foreign languages and attracting foreign specialists;
- training of foreign students in higher education.

The main advantages of internationalization of higher education:

- improvement of the quality of teaching, learning and scientific research;
- better training of students;
- expansion and deepening of contacts with national and international partners;
- expansion for students of access to educational programs to which access is possible impossible or limited for them in their countries;
- expansion of opportunities for improvement for professors and teachers staff and researchers;
- the opportunity to participate in international academic networks for conducting research, as well as the use of international experience;
- the possibility of increasing institutional efficiency due to enrichment international experience;
- improvement of institutional policy, management, service functions thanks to exchange by experience;
- promotion of the development of the state at the expense of new financial revenues and increase of human, intellectual and innovative capital;
- contribution to global development.



Internationalization can become the most important resource for the development of universities, their academic, cultural and humanitarian potential, and thus for the development of the country - human capital, intellectual, scientific, economic, political, social and cultural potential.

It is important that the process of internationalization of higher education is effectively managed and strategically properly directed.

All interested subjects of the educational process should ensure close control and improve the process taking into account modern requirements.



Ukraine and the Republic of Azerbaijan are countries with a sufficiently developed higher education system, which is integrated into the global education system to varying degrees.

It is very important to get the maximum benefit from internationalization of higher education without losing national advantages and interests.

Ukraine, as a candidate country for EU accession, has an opportunity to accelerate the internationalization of higher education, which will require significant efforts given the difficult situation related to the state of war in the country.
